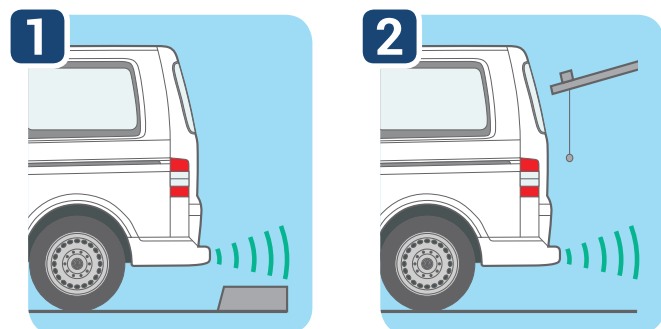


Parking Sensors

Thank you for choosing us to supply your new vehicle.
Your vehicle has been fitted with parking sensors to make parking safer and easier.
Below is a guide for using the parking sensors safely and correctly.

Your vehicle is fitted with a parking sensor system to help you park more safely and easily. Please note, all parking sensor systems are there as a driving aid and don't detect everything, so aren't a replacement for safe driving practices such as using your mirrors. Bristol Street Versa will not be liable for any incidental and consequential damages such as vehicle damage, personal injury or loss of income etc.



Parking sensor systems rely on either ultrasonic or electromagnetic waves to detect obstacles, so it may not work if the sensors are dirty or out of alignment. Small objects or objects that are too far above or below the sensors, kerbs (1) or garage doors (2) might not be picked up by the system.

Parking sensor systems are usually either dual sensor or quad sensor arrangements. If your vehicle has a lowered floor conversion, dual sensor systems must be used because the mid-section of the bumper is modified. **It's important for you to know that dual systems have a localised blind spot in the centre of the vehicle.** This only becomes a problem with narrow objects too close to the bumper. It will be detected from further away, but the alert will stop once it's in the blind spot.

Maintenance

Clean the surface of the sensors every so often with a piece of soft, damp cloth to remove any build-up of mud, traffic film or snow. Don't attempt to repair, modify or reconfigure the system yourself, as it may lead to malfunction or damage. In case of removal, adjustment or replacement of sensors, please contact your dealer.

Important Safety Notes

Parking sensors are strictly a driving aid and do not replace your mirrors, indicators or any other safety precautions you should use to ensure the safety of yourself, your passengers, other vehicles or pedestrians.

Please read and understand the full operating instructions supplied by the manufacturer for the system fitted to your vehicle.
